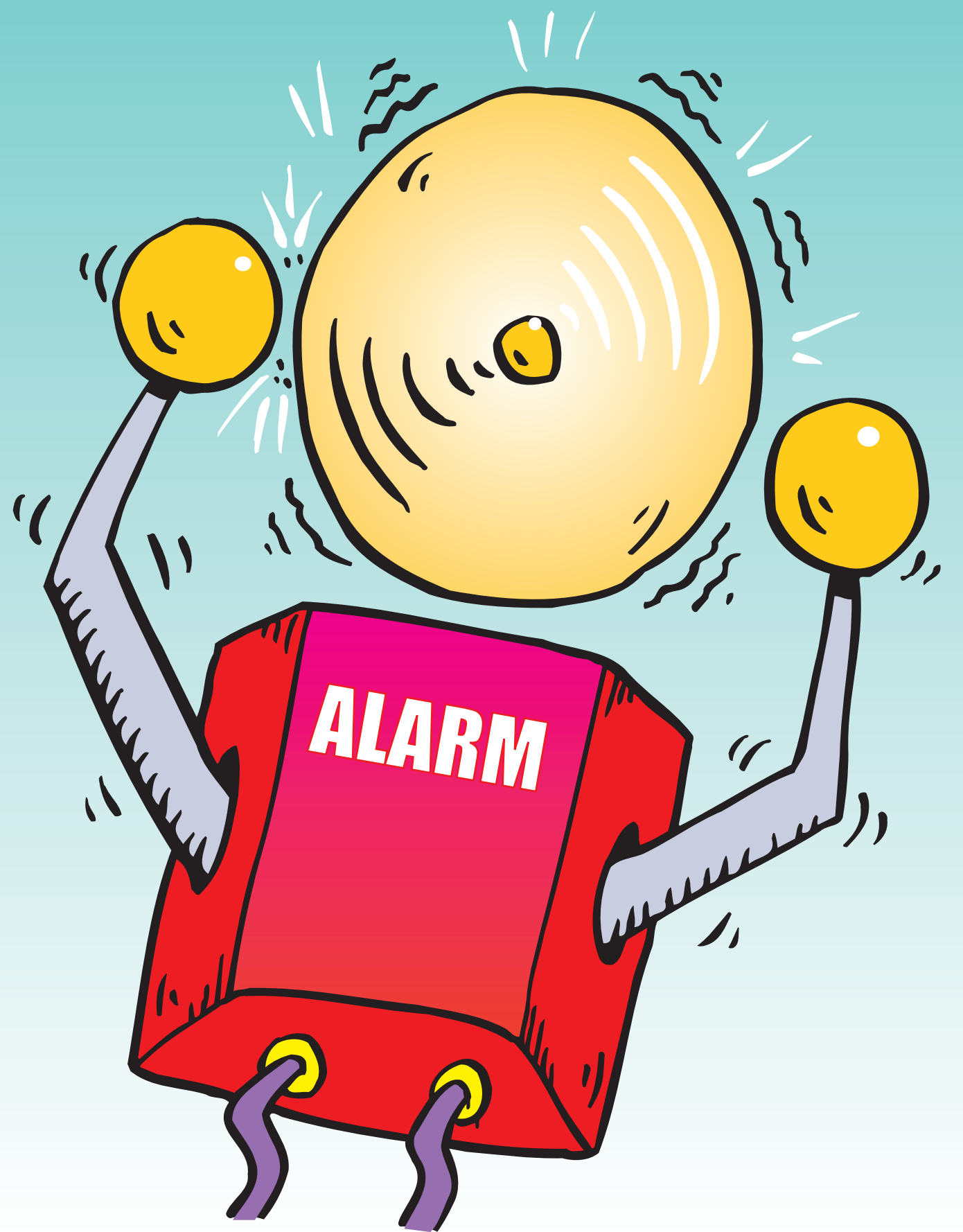


# DON'T ALARM YOUR NEIGHBOURS!



Intruder alarms can go off accidentally – disturbing your neighbours and costing you money if noise control officers are called in to silence them.



- ★ Ensure your alarm is installed by a qualified engineer
- ★ Have a cut out to stop it ringing for long periods
- ★ Keep your alarm maintained
- ★ Register your alarm with your local environmental health department, giving the contact details of two keyholders, so that it can be switched off if it accidentally goes off.
